## Privacy Notice

All guests must provide  
their name and contact information  
using the contact tracing form.

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- The CN Tower requires all guests to provide their name and contact information to support contact tracing by Toronto Public Health.
  - The CN Tower will only share this personal information with Toronto Public Health if it is relevant to an incident of COVID-19 exposure at the CN Tower on a particular day. Otherwise, CN Tower will retain this personal information for 21 days and then destroy it.
  - Declining to provide personal information means that you will not be permitted to go up the tower. Also, if you provide incomplete personal information, Toronto Public Health may be unable to contact you about possible exposure to COVID-19 during your visit today.

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This personal information is collected under the authority of the Privacy Act. All personal information collected by CN Tower is protected under the Privacy Act, which gives individuals certain rights, including: (i) the right to access and correct their personal information; and (ii) the right to file a complaint to the Privacy Commissioner of Canada regarding CN Tower's handling of personal information.
